HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

The need for a Govt, Degree College for Women in the District Headquarters was felt long back. and **SRI N.P. CHENGALRAYA NAIDU**, the former M.P, Chittoor came forward to donate a sum of Rs. 1 Lakh for starting the College. Consequent on his benevolent gesture and liberal donations, other philanthropists. Smt. N.P Savithramma Govt. College for Women came into existence on 24 November 1982 (G.ORT No 2192) in Chittoor.

Initially the College was started with two conventional courses B.A (HEP) TM and (GEN) TM in a private building in Guru Nagar Colony. Later it was shifted to P.V.K.N. Govt, College. Due to the sincere efforts of **Sri G. Muddu Krishnama Naidu Garu,** MLA, Puttur and former Minister of Higher Education, Government of A.P., 23.02 acres of land is acquired and funds are sanctioned for the college building.

Later Sri C.K. Jayachandra Reddy, M.LA. Chittoor, is involved in the construction of college building. Since 19 January, 1995 the College is running in this new building. Sri T.R.G.Krishna,

Principal took much interest in taking possession of the new building. The building was handed over without furniture, It was **Dr. M. Mohan Babu** former MP (Rajya Sabha) who was generous enough to allocate Rs.3.5lakhs from the M.P.LA.D., Scheme funds for the purchase of Class Room Furniture. The students and the public express deep sense of gratitude to **Dr. M. Mohan Babu** for providing funds.

Philanthropists who championed the cause of women's education like Sri. N.P. Venkateswara Chowdary was always in the fore front and contributed their might by extending their helping hand for the development of the institution right from its inception to date.

The academic year 1998-99 is a memorable period in the history of this college. As many as five restructured courses B.Sc., Computer Science, B.Sc., Microbiology, B. Com Computer Applications, B.A Computer Applications and B.B.M were introduced in this college in addition to the existing two conventional courses B.A(HEP) and B.com (GEN) with the sincere efforts of Dr. M. Narasimha Reddy Principal and the then Commissioner of Collegiate Education Sri. D.R. Garg. The introduction of new courses demanded the establishment of Computer Science, Microbiology, Zoology and Chemistry laboratories in the College which brought to light the acute shortage of accommodation.

At this juncture by the initiative taken by the principal **Dr. M. Narasimha Reddy** and many philanthropists/industrialists of the district came forward with huge donations. with which we were able to improve the infrastructure of the college. The laboratories were developed in the year 1999 2000. The list of contributors is given below.

Sri V. Vikram Reddy, Nutrine Group of Companies contributed Rs. 3,0 lakhs as 30% share of our 10.0 lakhs under Janma Bhoomi Programme for Sri B.V. Reddy Block. Sri B.V. Pattabhi Naidu, Contractor contributed Rs.1.2 lakhs as 30% share out of Rs.4.0 lakhs under Janma Bhoomi programme for compound wall, and Sri P. Krishnaiah, L.A.S. District Collector contributed Rs.0.25 lakh for Botanical Garden.

The former District Collector Sri S. Narasinga Rao, Sri B.N. Rajasimhulu (Philanthropist), Sri. V. Sudhakara Rao (Principal) and Sri N. Kannalah (Principal) were directly or indirectly involved in securing furniture for the College.

State government sanctioned liberally Rs. 47.99 lakhs for laboratory equipment, library books, and for the maintenance of the college which includes Rs. 10.0 lakhs for the establishment of second computer lab. With this grant all the laboratories were furnished with modern and sophisticated equipment. University Grants Commission also sanctioned a grant of Rs. 1.32 lakhs for the development of laboratories and purchase of Computer science books.

The long-cherished desire of the public of Chittoor was fulfilled with the introduction of M.S.c Microbiology Courses in the College from the academic year 2001-02. Another PG. Course Zoology was introduced in the year 2004. Two Microbiology Laboratories one for M.Sc., Previous and another for Final Year students were established with sophisticated equipment and the same were inaugurated by prof. P. Murali, Vice Chancellor of S.V. University & Dr. M. Narasimha Reddy, Ex-Principal of this College, Chittoor in connection with 20" College Day celebration on 22-03-2002

Two Labs, one Instrumentation Centre cum Research Laboratory was established in the Department of Zoology with sophisticated equipment and the same was inaugurated by Sri N.P. Venkatewara Chowdary and Dr. M. Narasimha Reddy on 28-06-05. Now the Dept of Zoology & Dept of Microbiology are recognized for conducting research by SVU Tirupati,

There is a well-equipped Library and information Center in this College around more than 15,517 Books and 4+ 2, Magazines & News Papers, Separate reading room facility and for reference purpose Internet service is available for Student and Staff members

Three Digital class room and one virtual classroom we established with all the modern equipment. These classes are utilized by the lecturer of all the subjects teach the concepts more effectively.

A Solar power plant was also established utilize RUSA funds as to reduce the dependency on the conventional come of electricity.

There is well equipped Physical Education Department having with 12 station Gym, Exercise Cycles-4, Jaggers-3, TT Board-1 and Magazines -4 with sufficient Ground facility playing for Tenny-koit (Courts -2), Shuttle Badminton (Court-1), Volley Ball (Court-1), Ball Badminton (Court-1), Kho-Kho (Court-1). Trains students in fitness programmes.

There is an Auditorium capable of accommodating one thousand members with all the facilities like furnished Dias, Sound System with two anti-rooms.



Attendance rules:

Then annual Attendance certificate required by the University for admitting the students to the University examinations will in no case be granted unless

- 1. The principal is satisfied that the students' progress and her conduct is satisfactory
- 2. The students has put in 75% of attendance to be eligible for promotion to the next year.

 Candidates who fall shorts of requisite attendance can seek condonation if they have put in at least 50% of the attendance, and apply through the principal after paying condonation fee.

Students who could not put in minimum of 50% of attendance are required to make up the deficiency of attendance during the next academic year in the same class by paying the following fee and became eligible for condonation on the recommendation of the principal. Such candidates are not eligible to the next class or to take the university examination.
